Title III-C Services - Cluster 1

Cluster 1 Services are services provided for older adults under OAA Title III for which ADL limitations and IADL limitations characteristics are reported in addition to the other consumer demographics and characteristics. These services are home-delivered meals, personal care, homemaker, chore, adult day care/health, and case management.

Service	Unit	Definition
Home Delivered Nutrition	Meals	A meal provided to a qualified individual in his/her place of residence. The meal is served in a program that is administered by SUAs and/or AAAs and meets all the requirements of the Older Americans Act and State/Local laws. Meals provided to individual through means-tested programs may be included.

Title III-C Services - Cluster 2

Cluster 2 Services are services provided for older adults under OAA Title III for which ADL limitations and IADL limitations characteristics are not reported. These services are congregate nutrition, nutrition counseling, and assisted transportation.

Service	Unit	Definition
Congregate Nutrition	Meals	A meal provided by a qualified nutrition project provider to a qualified individual in a congregate or group setting. The meal is served in a program that is administered by SUAs and/or AAAs and meets all the requirements of the Older Americans Act and State/Local laws. Meals provided to individuals through means-tested programs may be included.
Nutrition Counseling	Hours	A standardized service as defined by the Academy of Nutrition & Dietetics (AND) that provides individualized guidance to individuals who are at nutritional risk because of their health or nutrition history, dietary intake, chronic illness, or medication use, or to caregivers. Counseling is provided one-on-one by a registered dietitian, and addresses the options and methods for improving nutrition status with a measurable goal.

Consumer Demographics

- Consumer demographic information is used in the aggregate for Persons Receiving Registered Services (Clusters 1 & 2), Persons Receiving Registered Services (Cluster 1), and with Cluster 1 and Cluster 2 services.
- For Clusters 1 & 2, each demographic element is intersected by At or Below Poverty. For Cluster 1 only, each demographic element is intersected by At or Below Poverty, ADL 3+, and IADL 3+.
- For definition of Cluster 1 services, see this <u>section</u>; for Cluster 2 services, see this <u>section</u>. Consumer Demographic info will need to be reported for each Cluster 1 and Cluster 2 service, as well as Older Adults as a whole.

Title III-C Services – Non-Registered Services

A **non-registered service** is a service provided using OAA funds in whole or in part for which demographic and consumer characteristics are not reported to ACL/AoA. The services for older adult consumers under Title III-C include nutrition education services.

Service	Unit	Definition
Nutrition Education	Sessions	A targeted program to promote better health by providing accurate and culturally sensitive nutrition, physical fitness, or health (as it relates to nutrition) information that is consistent with the current Dietary Guidelines for Americans and instruction to participants, caregivers, or participants and caregivers in a group or individual setting overseen by a dietitian or individual of comparable expertise.
