If you are a resident of Kennebunkport, and you need food assistance, PLEASE call the Public Health office 967-4 1 and request food assistance or you can go on line and fill out the food request form with Community Outreach Sservices (COS). Community Outreach Services (COS) Food Pantry serves residents of Arundel, Kennebunk and Kennebunkport Monday-Friday. Residents are requested to contact the Public Health Department if they are in ne of food or personal supplies assistance-967-4401. Weekly produce pantry is also available, Friday morning at 9am St Martha's church. For other congregate meals contact the public health office for location/times.

Call Kennebunkport Public Health Department 967-4401 to sign up for one of the monthly foot care clinics (clinics are not limited to town residents). There is a \$35.00 fee per client. Fees are due at the time of service in cash, or check made to the Town of Kennebunkport.

If you are a diabetic patient, you will need to ge a referral from your podiatrist first. Plan to spend about 30-45 minutes at each appointment. Other skilled nursing assistance provided - dressing changes, catheter changes, medication administration, blood sugar and blood pressure monitoring.

Placing the yellow dot sticker in the lower left corner c your vehicle's rear window notifies first responders that there is vital medical information in the vehicle's glove bo This information is extremely important when a person is in medical distress and cannot speak to the first responders. Each Yellow Dot envelope contains a personal information sheet and a yellow window decal. There should be one personal information sheet for every person that regularly uses the vehicle. Fill the sheet out with pencil to allow for easy updating whenever medical information changes. Store the information sheets in the yello envelope and keep in glove compartment of the vehicle.
